It should be noted that the Ministerial Decree No. 609 / 2020 (3 pages, in Arabic) which was formerly notified in G/TBT/N/EGY/171/Add.1 dated 31 March 2021 mandated among others the earlier version of this Egyptian standard.

Worth mentioning is that this draft standard is technically identical with EN 12209/ 2016
