### *Corrigendum*

The following communication, received on 10 June 2015, is being circulated at the request of the Delegation of Egypt.

In the notification G/TBT/N/EGY/70, Items 5, 8 and 9 should read (changes are underlined and in bold) and Item 6 should read:

5.	<b>Title, number of pages and language(s) of the notified document:</b> Ministerial Decree <b><u>No. 974/2014 (1 pages, in Arabic) on the mandatory</u></b> Egyptian Standard ES 7093/2014 "Essential Requirements for Safety of Toys" (119 pages, in Arabic)
6.	<b>Description of content:</b> The Ministerial Decree mandates that the producers and importers must comply with ES7093/2014. This Egyptian Standard specifies the essential requirements for safety of toys (mechanical and physical properties, flammability and chemical properties, hygiene, electrical properties and radioactivity).  It is worth mentioning is that this standard complies with 2009/48/EC.
